LIGHTS. CAMERA. ACTION!

a free workshop for young people who hear, see or sense things that other people don't



WHAT:

Have your say ... about the world, yourself, your experiences, your hopes, your uniqueness, mental health or even hearing voices.

In this interactive workshop, led by Ibi Vaughan (an experienced film maker) you'll have the chance to create a number of short, 30-second to one-minute, 'adverts'. They can be as fun or as serious as you want.

We'll start with a chance to develop your ideas as a storyboard, using pictures, photographs or sketches. We'll then record the scenes, enabling you to try out different roles - director, sound recorder, camera operator etc.

We'll edit what you've filmed and add some finishing touches to bring it all together (e.g. music, voice-overs and photographs). Finally, you will be able to take the adverts home with you on a DVD.

WHO CAN COME?

The workshop is open to any young person (aged 18 or under) who hears or sees things that other people don't.

WHAT ABOUT PARENTS SUPPORTERS?

If you have a parent or family member you'd like to bring along, we're running a support workshop just for them in another room. Just get them to book a place too.
