

## International Consortium on Hallucinations Research



### 2016 Travel Scholarship

The International Consortium on Hallucination Research (ICHR) provides a scientific platform for researchers, mental health professionals, and people with a lived experience of hallucinations to collaborate and share ideas.

The ICHR Steering Committee are pleased to announce that they will make a travel scholarship available this year to support a PhD student to attend the Inaugural North American Conference of the ICHR, to be held on 26-27<sup>th</sup> September 2016 at the University of Illinois, Chicago, IL, USA.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be enrolled in a PhD program at an accredited university or college, which may be located anywhere worldwide. The PhD should be on a topic related to hallucinations, but may be in any discipline. The successful candidate should be willing to write a short blog post after the event on their experience of the conference, to be posted on the ICHR website. Applicants should not be a PhD student of a member of the ICHR Steering Committee (<http://hallucinationconsortium.org/about/about-steering-committee/>).

**Funding:** Up to USD \$1,000 will be made available to support the travel costs of the successful applicant, which can include transportation (flights should be economy class) and accommodation. This money will be reimbursed to the successful applicant after the conference, upon production of receipts, and cannot be provided up-front.

**How to apply:** Applicants should make their case for the travel scholarship on a single A4 page, which should include an explanation of the relevance of the event to their own research, and how attending the event will further their work. This should be followed by a one-page CV, including name, current address, position, title of PhD project, names of PhD supervisors, and the name of a potential referee (e.g., your supervisor).

The resultant two-page application should be emailed to A/Prof Simon McCarthy-Jones ([simon.mccarthy-jones@tcd.ie](mailto:simon.mccarthy-jones@tcd.ie)) by 6pm GMT on Friday 20th May 2016.

**Evaluation:** Decisions will be based on the quality of the submitted information, and will be assessed by members of the ICHR Steering Committee.

**Outcome:** The successful applicant will be informed of the outcome by email by 10<sup>th</sup> June 2016. Unfortunately, individual feedback on unsuccessful applications is not possible.
